Normal form: ∫i:; weak form ∫i

The strong form, / $\int i$: / is used mainly contrastively (e.g. 'I wouldn't go, so SHE went') or emphatically (e.g. 'What does SHE want?'). The weak form is $\int i$ / (e.g. 'off **she** went', /pf $\int i$ went/); 'Why did **she** read it?' / war drd $\int i$ 'ri:d rt/; 'Who is **she**?' / 'hu: 'rz $\int i$ /).
