

## Lesson Ten

### She

Normal form: /ʃi:/; weak form /ʃi/

The strong form, / ʃi: / is used mainly contrastively (e.g. ‘I wouldn’t go, so **SHE** went’) or emphatically (e.g. ‘What does **SHE** want?’). The weak form is /ʃi/ (e.g. ‘off **she** went’, /ɒf ʃi 'went/); ‘Why did **she** read it?’ / waɪ dɪd ʃi 'ri:d it/; ‘Who is **she**?’ / 'hu: 'ɪz ʃi/).
