The strong form is used contrastively, (e.g. 'We, not they, will win it') or for emphasis, (e.g. 'We are the winners'). It is also used in final position (e.g. 'So are we'). Weak form: / wi / (e.g. 'How can we get there?' / 'hau kən wi 'get ðeə/; 'We need that, don't we?' / wi 'ni: d ðæt 'dəunt wi /).
