Strong form: **hɪm**; weak form: **ɪm**

The strong form is mainly used for contrastive purposes, (e.g. 'The gift is for **him**, not her'). Weak form is / **ɪm** / (e.g. 'Leave **him** alone' / 'li:v **ɪm** ə'ləʊn /; 'I've seen **him**' / aɪv 'si: n **ɪm** /).
