## Lesson Twenty-two As

Strong form: æz; weak form: əz

The strong form / æz / is used in contrastive or coordinative constructions (e.g. 'as and when it's ready'), and in sentence-final position (e.g. 'That's what I bought it as'). Quite frequently the strong form is found when the word occurs in initial position in a sentence if the following word is not stressed (e.g. 'As I was saying...' / <code>az ai wəz 'seiin /</code>). The weak form is / <code>əz / (e.g. 'As much as possible' / <code>əz 'mʌtf əz 'ppsibl /; 'as good as gold' / <code>əz \_gud əz gəuld /</code>).</code></code>
