Strong form: wdz; weak forms: wdz, wz

The strong form is used in contrastive contexts (e.g. 'I don't know whether it was or it wasn't'), and for emphasis (e.g. 'I was right!'). The strong form is also used in final position (e.g. 'that's where it was'). The weak forms are used elsewhere, (e.g. 'He was here a minute ago' / hi wəz 'hiər ə 'minit ə'gəu /), the form / wz / is found only in rapid, casual speech.
