Lesson Seven His

Strong form: hiz; weak form: iz

The strong form / hIZ / is always used when the word occurs contrastively, (e.g. 'It's **his** not hers'), and when it is in final position, (e.g. 'He said it was **his**'). When the word is unstressed the weak pronunciation is usually / IZ / (e.g. 'Take **his** name', / 'telk IZ 'nelm /).

(Another sense of 'his', as in 'it was **his**', / It wəz 'hɪz/; 'His was late'/ 'hɪz wəz 'leɪt /, always has the strong form.)
